

# LCS Special Programs Overview

## Central Virginia Governor's School for Science & Technology

1. Fill out the application form online at [www.cvgs.k12.va.us](http://www.cvgs.k12.va.us) or print a paper copy; Your computer must have [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) installed to fill out the [application](#). When you are finished, save it and print out a hard copy to turn in to your school counselor by the **February 19, 2018**.
2. Attend a CVGS Program Overview Night; this isn't required, but is recommended if you want to learn more about the program. **Jan. 23 7-9:00pm**
3. Ask your school counselor to complete the [student record form](#).
4. Ask three of your teachers (1 math teacher, 1 science teacher, and 1 other teacher) to write recommendations for you using the [recommendation](#) form provided. You can save the form and email it to your teachers, or provide them with a link to this website. Of course, their computers must also have [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) installed to fill out the recommendation. Once completed, teachers should print out the recommendation and return it to your guidance counselor.
5. Make sure you are signed up to take the CVCC VPT test at **HHS on January 23-24<sup>th</sup>**. [Click here for the CVCC VPT Sign-Up form](#).

## LCS-Central Virginia Community College Early College Program

1. Fill out the application form that is in the School Counseling Office. Please make sure you have met the following criteria:
  - a. Students' GPA must be 3.0 or higher to apply
  - b. Students must be enrolled or passed Algebra II and Chemistry
  - c. Student must have taken the VPT test for Math & English (**January 23-24<sup>th</sup> at HHS**)
2. Encouraged to attend Early College Open House with parents on **Tuesday, January 23 at 6pm at CVCC-Merritt Hall**
3. Ask 2 teachers and your school counselor to complete the recommendation forms (1 Math required and 1 of choice, Counselor)
4. Apply as a student at [cvcc.vccs.edu](http://cvcc.vccs.edu) and write down your CVCC ID number that will be given to you after you apply as a student CVCC ID: \_\_\_\_\_

4. Print out and ask three of your teachers (1 math teacher, 1 science teacher, and 1 other teacher) to complete the recommendation form provided. Teachers must submit it to your counselor.
